Capacity: For all classes, there will be a teaching artist and staff person present. Our policy is to always have a minimum of two staff (one teaching artist, one Jubilee Arts team member) people present during classes.

Visual art studio: 10 students and min 2 staff Dance studio: 15 students and min 2 staff
